Preparing for A Level Maths

The best thing to do to help prepare for A Level Maths is to focus on the more basic algebra content within GCSE Maths – rearranging formulae, solving equations, solving quadratic equations, indices and surds and being familiar with basic graphs. Basic trigonometry would also be good to look over (Pythagoras, SOHCAHTOA, sine and cosine rules).
