

## Student Bursary Portal

Bursary applications for 2026/27 open from **7<sup>th</sup> April 2026**.

Existing students and September 2026 applicants who wish to apply for financial help with transport, essential course costs and/or free college meals, can submit a bursary application via the [Student Bursary Portal](#).

### Who is eligible?

If your **net** household income is less than £50,000, you could be eligible for a bursary. Our bursaries are designed to help with the essential costs of taking part in education at the college (for example travel, meals and required equipment).

### Who can apply?

Students can apply for themselves. To complete the application you will need to upload income evidence for **all** members of your household, except siblings. Your parent/guardian can apply on your behalf.

### How do I apply?

#### 1. Registering and activating your account:

Register with your student ID number, date of birth, to create and confirm your password. You can find your student number on the [Applications Portal](#).

An activation email will be sent to your personal email address and the email address for the first next of kin from your college application.

If you are a September 2026 applicant and one or both of these email addresses are incorrect, please contact [admissions@callywith.ac.uk](mailto:admissions@callywith.ac.uk) to get this information updated.

#### Register

If you are currently studying at the College or have applied to join in September 2025, please use this form to register for a bursary portal account. This will send a link to the personal email address we have on file for you (the student). If you are a student joining the college in September 2025, this will be the email address you originally used to apply for college. Please note, this may have been your next of kin's email.

When your account is activated, you will be able to login to your account and complete a bursary application.

Your student ID number can be found on the [Applications Portal](#). Please enter just the number from your ID, not the initials, e.g. 123456

If you receive an error message reading **Student details not valid** this means it does not recognise the combination of student ID number and date of birth. Please check that you have entered both correctly. If it still does not recognise these details, it is possible that we have something different on our system from your original application. 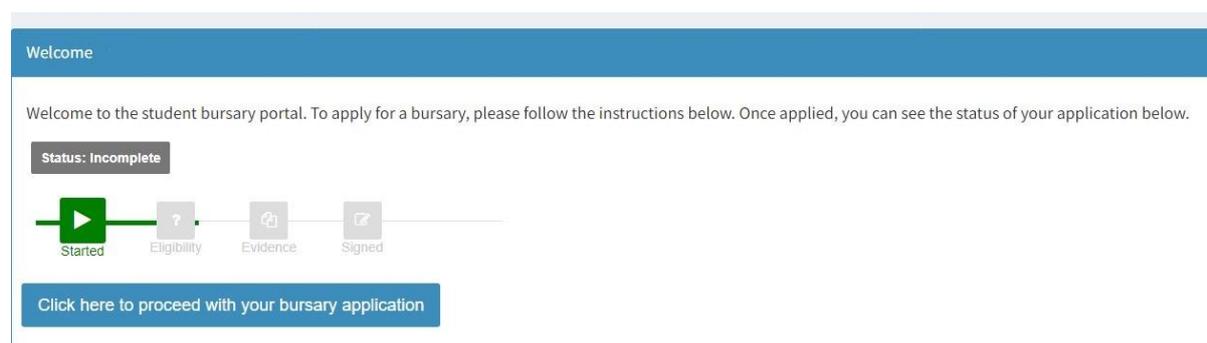
